- Dance music: Your dancer's recital music will be sent to you via email so they may practice at home. Recital music will be emailed to each class once it is finalized. Please be patient with us if you have only received some of your dancer's music. Some of the songs need to be adjusted and once that is complete and email will go out.
- Information: Recital/Ticket informational packets will be mailed on April 1st to everyone that has a dancer in the recital. The packets will include important information, please be sure to read thoroughly. Statements will also be sent for those accounts that still have balances.

 If you wish to have a ticket packet sent to two separate addresses, please let us know.
- Perfect Attendance, 5/10/15 year awards: If you believe your child has perfect attendance or should be getting either their 5/10/15 year award please let us know.
- Sign-up Sheets for the Recital Bake Sale, T-Shirt as well as the Basket Raffles are posted at the studio.
- Tickets: If your dancer is taking a class that is <u>not</u> in the recital, but you would still like to attend the show, tickets will be available at the door for purchase for each show. Tickets are \$12.00 each.

Arriving ON TIME

It is <u>important that students arrive</u> on time for class. The warm-up is the most important part of the class and some of the steps that are taught in the warm-up are used for their recital routines.

For the younger children – part of the steps in their routine are taught at the barre so that they will recognize the step when it's incorporated in their routine/choreography.

Attendance! Important as well!
Students fall behind and can get lost if they are not familiar with the choreography. Other students in class may also be somewhat confused if a person is missing from the choreography.

Recital is only 1 ½ months away!

All routines have to be completed by April 13th to give all the dancers time after we break for April

time after we break for April vacation, to master their steps.

Bad Weather Cancellation

The PDC does not always close when school is closed.

If classes are canceled due to inclement weather, a message will be left on the studio phone as well as posted on Facebook. Classes may be held if the weather clears by the afternoon and driving conditions are safe.
